In the process to finalize the country report 2008 to UNAIDS (Fig.1), all the sectors (Government, Medical Sectors, Researchers and NGOs including PLHIV) were involved (Fig.2). After the country report 2006 to UNAIDS proceeded to '3 ones' and 'GIPA', the Assessment and Review Committee on HIV/AIDS Measures was established on September 15 in 2006, members from various sectors including NGOs, PLHIV and local governments were involved in monitoring HIV/AIDS measures.

I hope that Japanese context in HIV/AIDS measures will be shared to efforts to provide Universal Access to Prevention, Treatment, Care & Support.

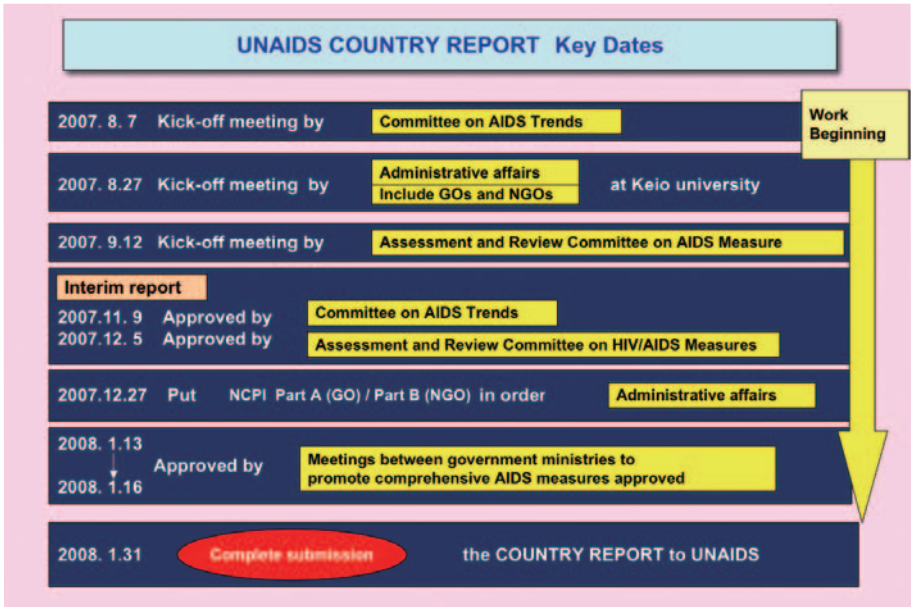
