Since the first cases of HIV were reported more than 35 years ago, 78 million people have become infected with HIV and 35 million have died from AIDS-related illnesses. Since it started operations in 1996, UNAIDS has led and inspired global, regional, national and local leadership, innovation and partnership with the ultimate goal of consigning HIV to history.

Why UNAIDS?

An exciting mandate...

UNAIDS is leading global effort to end AIDS as a public health threat by 2030 as part of the Sustainable Development Goals.

UNAIDS places people living with HIV and people affected by the virus at the decision-making table and at the centre of designing, delivering and monitoring the AIDS response. It is a bold advocate for addressing the legal and policy barriers to the AIDS response. It brings together communities that have been left out of decision-making.

UNAIDS provides strategic direction, advocacy, coordination and technical support to catalyse and connect leader from governments, the private sector and communities.

UNAIDS leads the world's most extensive data collection on HIV epidemiology, programme coverage and finance, that is vital for an effective AIDS response.

UNAIDS is a model for UN Reform and is the only cosponsored Joint Programme in the UN system. It draws on the expertise of 11 United Nations system Cosponsors and is the only UN entity with civil society represented on its governing body.

Opening up opportunities...

The UNAIDS Secretariat has offices in 70 countries, with 70% of its staff based in the field.

Thanks to the cosponsored nature of UNAIDS, our Junior Professional Officers (JPOs) are exposed to a wide spectrum of UN agencies and programmes. This has helped several former JPOs to find employment within the UN or with international NGOs.

An induction programme and a new mentoring opportunity are offered to first-year JPOs to ensure an effective introduction and support in first steps in their new job.

The JPO Get-Together webinar series is being relaunched to build knowledge of UNAIDS and the UN System, and facilitate networking.

JPOs have access to the same learning opportunities as staff members. In addition, a new learning and development framework is being designed in consultation with current JPOs.

HRM regularly checks in with JPOs to ensure a valuable learning experience and provide advice to supervisors.

JPOs have the status of internal candidates in competitive selection processes for UNAIDS positions.

In recent years, during their assignment 16 UNAIDS JPOs were selected for UNAIDS Secretariat staff positions at the P2, P3 and P4 levels.

Junior Professional Officers in UNAIDS

Over the last decade UNAIDS has welcomed 66 JPOs, two thirds of whom have been women, thanks to the support of 13 donor countries. We are actively seeking to extend opportunities with other donor countries.
